

JUNIOR JUDGING

Junior Judging competitions will be held in Meat Breeds Sheep, Merino Sheep, Merino Fleece (Wool Section) and Beef Cattle.

Entry Fee: FREE to enter all Junior Judging sections. Entries taken on the day.

Entries Close: With the Chief Steward by 9.30am Friday 5th March.

Prize Money: In addition to ribbons for the first three places of each section, there are special prizes. If insufficient entries are received, some special prizes may not be awarded. This is at the discretion of the Chief Steward.

Conditions:

1. Registration will be open from 9am at the Sheep Pavilion, Mudgee Showground.
2. Judging will commence at 9.30am.
3. Competitors must be over 15 and under 25 years of age on 1st May 2010
4. Competitors can compete in only one Group Final however it is not necessary to reside within the boundaries of the Group conducting the final.
5. The Hormel Slide is used at the Group and State Finals.
6. The first two place getters in each section will represent the Group at the State Finals except for Merino where only one is represented.
7. Competitors should be dressed appropriately and bring a pen/pencil.
8. There will be a group rotation system where competitors will be required to handle sheep for others to judge.

Category 1

The Group Finals for Castlereagh Group 12 (which includes Mudgee Show Society) will be held in t
