## NEEDLEWORK

- 30101 Any article made by a resident of Mid-Western Regional Council Aged 70years & over
- 30102 Creative or Wool Embroidery
- 30103 Article of Tatting or Bobbin Lace
- 30104 Any Article of Tapestry
- 30105 Article using candle wicking
- 30106 Any other article of embroidery
- 30107 Any article of smocking
- 30108 Christening robe/baby's frock
- 30109 Child's garment
- 30110 Any other article of dressmaking



## QUILTING

- 30111 Quilt/wall hanging - machine pieced
- 30112 Quilt/wall hanging - hand pieced
- 30113 Quilt/wall hanging - machine appliqué
- 30114 Quilt/wall hanging - hand appliqué
- 30115 Quilt/wall hanging - commercially quilted (entrant's top; commercially quilted by another)
- 30116 Quilt/wall hanging - hand quilted
- 30117 Article less than 1 metre square (eg wall hanging) using quilting and/or appliqué
- 30118 Quilt/wall hanging made by a novice

## CROSS STITCH

- 30119 Counted cross stitch
- 30120 Cross stitch book mark/card

## SEWING

- 30121 An article of soft furnishings (e.g. cushion, lampshade etc)
- 30122 Tea cosy
- 30123 Coat hanger
- 30124 Dressed doll - not porcelain
- 30126 Teddy bear
- 30127 Clown, Doll or toy etc
- 30128 Bag - using any technique (e.g. patchwork, embroidery)
